

# Referral to attend the Breast Cancer Family Clinic

## Eligibility criteria to attend the Breast Cancer Family Clinic

Women aged **30–49 years** who meet the Familial Risk Assessment – Breast and Ovarian Cancer (FRA-BOC) Risk Category 3 status criteria:

- Two 1 degree or 2 degree relatives on one side of the family diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer **plus** one or more of the following features on the same side of the family:
  - additional relative(s) with breast or ovarian cancer
  - breast and ovarian cancer in the same women
  - breast cancer diagnosed before the age of 40
  - Jewish ancestry
  - bilateral breast cancer
  - breast cancer in a male relative.
- Member of a family in which the presence of a high risk breast cancer gene mutation has been established.
- Women who are at potentially high risk of ovarian cancer.
