

Referral to attend the Breast Cancer Family Clinic

Eligibility criteria to attend the Breast Cancer Family Clinic

Women aged 30–59 years who meet the NBOCC Risk Category 3 status criteria:

- Two 1 degree or 2 degree relatives on one side of the family diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer **plus** one or more of the following features on the same side of the family:
- additional relative(s) with breast or ovarian cancer
 - breast cancer diagnosed before the age of 40
 - bilateral breast cancer
 - breast and ovarian cancer in the same women
 - Jewish ancestry
 - breast cancer in a male relative.
- One 1 degree or 2 degree relative diagnosed with breast cancer at age 45 or younger **plus** another 1 degree or 2 degree relative on the same side of the family with sarcoma (bone/soft tissue) at age 45 or younger.
- Member of a family in which the presence of a high risk breast cancer gene mutation has been established.
- Women who are at potentially high risk of ovarian cancer.
